ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land, together with all buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Piney Mountain Road, lying between the rights of way of Southern Railway and P. and N. Railway, and being more particularly described according to a topographic map prepared for Precision Machine Works, Inc. by James M. Beeson, September 7, 1954 as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on Piney Mountain Road, at or near the Southern side of Bridge crossing the P. and N. Railway, and running thence along a curved line approximately parallel to and 42-1/2 feet distance from the center of the P. and N. The Mortgagor covenants that it is lewfully seized of the premises bereinshove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is the fully sutherized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided to be berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and the squares and all persons whomseever lewfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, resdvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
