TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: Dated at Greenville, South Carolina, this 23rd day of June,

of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagors, send greeting:

WHEREAS, the said Mortgagors are justly indebted to FINANCE ONE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, INC., hereinafter called the Mortgagee, and have given their promissory Note therefore bearing even date herewith, whereby they have promised to pay to the Mortgagee in accordance with its terms the Actual Amount of Loan of \$ 4,825.00..... together with interest on unpaid balances, it being hereby expressly agreed that upon default in the payment of said note or of any charge in connection therewith, or of insurance premiums, taxes or assessments or in the performance of any of the requirements herein contained as to taxes or insurance or of any of the other conditions hereof, the Mortgagee shall have the right to declare immediately due and payable the entire unpaid principal balance hereof and accrued interest thereon, and to proceed, without notice, to enforce the collection of same as provided therein, together with a reasonable attorney's fee up to 15% of said unpaid balance for any litigation concerning the debt, and all other amounts secured hereby.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN That the Mortgagors, in order better to secure the payment of the note above mentioned in accordance with its terms, and all other sums mentioned therein or herein, to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of TEN DOLLARS to the Mortgagors in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real property:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, S. C. on the southwestern side of Miller Street (formerly Main Avenue) in a section known as Michleton, and being half and divided into Lot 23 on one section and Lot 22 on a plot prepared by J. L. Hayes, Surveyor, dated 1914, entitled "Title of Subdivision of J. L. Miller and W. P. Johnson, Esq.", filed in the City Office for Greenville County, J. L. Miller and W. P. Johnson, Date 1914, and the chain on a plot entitled "Property of J. L. Miller and W. P. Johnson, Esq.", prepared by J. L. Miller Surveying Co., recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Greenville, in Book 1972, Page 664, and having such number of feet in width thereon.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to the state herein by deed of Maynard D. Brighty, Trustee, dated 10 January, 1913, in the County Registry, in Bruce Bryan, Surveyor recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Book 1972, Page 664, on 10 January 1913.

This conveyance is subject to any and all existing encumbrances, cements, rights of way, easings or franchises, and reservations or protective covenants that may appear of record, on the record title(s) or on the premises.

This property is subject to a joint tenancy with the adjoining property in chain on the latter plot above referred to.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever.

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
