9. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any mation or other taking of the Property, or part thereof, or for surement of the consequential, in connection with any demination of other taking of the Property, or part thereof, or for conveyance in her of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to 1 ender

In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower.
