WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

organized and existing under the laws of Iowa

called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Sixty Thousand and No/100-----

Dollars (\$ 60,000.00)

with interest from date at the rate of Twelve

per centum 12

per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Bancers Life Company
in Des Moines, Iowa

or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Two Hundred

Twenty and 00/100----- Dollars (\$ 200.00)

commencing on the first day of October 1933, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of September, 1933.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagee, it has well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville:

State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina on the southeastern side of Parliament Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 18, on plat of Merrifield Park, Section 1, recorded in the Plat Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book 192 at page 51 and file. Reference to said plat is hereby made for a more particular description.

This being the same property referred to in the aforesaid heretofore by deed of Ralph G. Smith, Jr. and Anna Mae Smith as recorded in Land Book 1152 at page 479, in the Plat Office for Greenville County, S.C., on July 23, 1931.

Together with all and any and all the rights, members, hereditaments, appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the fixtures, utensils, chattels which may at the time of the sale be part of the same, including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully owner of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and title thereto, free and clear of all encumbrances, and that the same is not subject to any lien, charge, or claim of any kind, and that the Mortgagee shall have full power to sue thereon in the name of the Mortgagor to recover the amount of the principal sum and interest due and owing to the Mortgagee.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees to:

1. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, and other charges which may be levied upon the property herein described, and that he will keep the same in good repair and in a safe condition, and that he will not do any damage to the property herein described, and that he will not do any damage to the property herein described.
