SEND GREETING

WHEREAS, I, the said Annie M. Meadows, in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, am well and truly indebted unto the **CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION**, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and no/100-----(\$ 2,500.00-----) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of thirteen and one-half per cent (13½ %) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

Sixty-seven and 70/100-----(\$ 67.70-----) Dollars due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any, incurred, and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the said mortgagee, in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said **CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION**, Greer, S. Office for Greenville County in Court Book 34 at Page 160, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of said lot, iron pin on line at 17 feet, and runs thence with the original line N. 44-15 W. 220 feet to an iron pin on the said line, thence a new line N. 10-24 W. 270 feet to an iron pin; thence another new line N. 35-45 E. 220.2 feet to a point in the center of the said river bank; iron pin back on line at 20 feet; thence with the center of said bank N. 10-11 E. 171 feet to the beginning corner, and containing forty-five one-hundredths (.45) of one acre, more or less.
