C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor—in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, located in the City of Greer on the Southwestern side of Church Street and being shown and designated as all of lot number ONE (1) on plat of property of Harry & Annie Switzer Estate made by John A. Simmons, surveyor, dated Oct. 11, 1968 and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the outside edge of sidewalk at corner of the Dr. Allen lot onSouthwestern edge of sidewalk, (iron pin set back at 5.5 feet at inside edge of sidewalk) and running thence along the outside edge of sidewalk N. 65-25 W., 94.2 feet to corner of lot No. 2 on side plat; thence S. 21-52 W., 61.2 feet along lot No 2 to an iron pin on the line of Mrs. Junningham lot; thence with said lot S. 66-50 E., 92.8 feet to old iron pin on line of Dr. Allen lot; thence with the Allen lot N. 23-10 E., 59.1 feet to the beginning corner. (Subject however to sidewalk right of way.)

This is a part of the same conveyed to Harry & Annie Switzer by deed recorded in deed book 75 page 567, the interest of Harry Switzer being conveyed to Annie Switzer by deed recorded in deed book 166 page 426, Annie Switzer died testate Dec. 20, 1961 with life estate to Harry Switzer. Harry Switzer died testate July 4, 1964, Milton Switzer died testate Sept. 27, 1967willing all property to wife, Mildred Collins Switzer.
