WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagor for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying, and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Pleasantburg Drive (State Highway No. 291), and on the Northern side of Regency Hills Drive, containing 0.29 acres, and being shown and delineated on a Survey for Harold H. Park, et al., by Carolina Surveying Co., dated March 5, 1980, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book 7-2, at Page 73, and having such metes and bounds as shown thereon.

This is the identical property conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by Deed of Vincent J. Perone, dated of even date herewith, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Yolume $\frac{262}{202}$, at Page $\frac{273}{202}$, on December $\frac{2}{2}$, 1983, at $\frac{2}{2}$.M.

The Mortgagee herein agrees to subordinate this Mortgage to a construction loan upon request of the Mortgagor herein, provided that payments are current.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, inues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fixted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the areal household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgages, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully setted of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and excumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgages by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing

(2) That it will keep the improvements now esisting or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not loss than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that ill such policies and tenewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable claimes in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due, and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the perceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged promises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the bilinee owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.
