That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Oneal Township, being designated as Lot No. 18 on a plat entitled, "Jamestown Estates, Section Two," prepared by Campbell & Clarkson, Surveyors, dated November 30, 1972 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4-X at page 68 and having such metes and bounds as appear by reference to said plat. The subject lot fronts on the westerly side of Williamsburg Drive, a total distance of 200.8 feet.

This is a portion of a 10.89 acre tract conveyed to Ratterree-James Insurance Agency by deed of Buford R. Chandler, recorded on June 19, 1968 in Deed Book 846 at Page 594.

This property is conveyed subject to any and all easements or rights-of-way affecting same and specifically to the restrictions and protective covenants recorded in Deed Book 914 at page 279 and in Deed Book 1032 at Page 634, which covenants are hereby amended as to the subject lot to repuire that no dwelling constructed thereon shall contain less that 2,000 square feet in the main structure, exclusive of open porches and garages.
