WHEREAS, we, James O. Williams and Mary K. Williams,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto Sharonview Federal Credit Union, P. O. Box 32414, Charlotte, NC 28232,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Fifty Thousand and No/100----- Dollars (\$ 50,000.00) due and payable

according to the terms and provisions of the note of even date which this mortgage secures

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 11.50 per centum per annum, to be paid: monthly.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, shown and designated as Lot No. 44 on plat of SUNSET HEIGHTS recorded in Plat Book RR, at Page 85, and a more recent plat of Property of Duane P. Dostie, prepared by J. L. Montgomery, III, dated January 16, 1978, and recorded in Plat Book 68, at Page 12, and having, according to the more recent plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Evening Way, joint corner with Lot 45 and running thence along Evening Way, N. 83-16 W. 42.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with a curve in the road, S. 55-41 W. 60.1 feet to an iron pin on Vesper Circle; thence with said Vesper Circle, S. 14-38 W. 127 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot No. 64; thence with said lot line, S. 69-44 E. 199.6 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running with the common line of Lots 45 and 44, N. 16-16 W. 229.5 feet to an iron pin on Evening Way, the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagors herein by deed of Carl R. Martin and Betty L. Martin dated July 3, 1984, and recorded simultaneously herewith in Deed Book 1216, at Page 687.
