NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgager in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, burgained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, with improvements thereon situate on the Southwest side of Pinckney Street and having the following metes and bounds.

BEGINNING at a point on said Street 133 feet from corner of Frank Street and running thence in a parallel line with Frank Street west, 102 feet; thence in a line parallel with Pinckney Street and in a Southerly direction 32 feet; thence in a Easterly direction 12 feet to an iron pin on an alley at a point 96 feet from Pinkney Street; thence along the line of said alley 96 feet to Pinckney Street; thence along said street 42 feet towards Frank Street north to the beginning corner.

THIS property is known and designated as Block Book No. 27-1-11.

BEING the same property devised to Bertha Evans by will of her mother Floried Martha Evans who died Testate 12-26-59, see Probate File 722-20. Subsequently Bertha Evans, now Bertha Evans Brookshire conveyed a 1/2 interest in this property to Henry A. Brookshire, by deed recorded in Deed Book 778 at page 232, on 7-22-65. Henry A. Brookshire died testate 11-19-81 leaving his 1/2 interest in the property to Bertha Evans Brookshire see Probate File 1686-2.

FUTURE ADVANCES: As additional consideration, pursuant to Section 29-3-50 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, this mortgage is given to cover, in addition to all existing indebtedness of Mortgagor to Mortgagee (including but not limited to the abovedescribed advances) evidenced by promissory notes, and all renewal and extensions thereof, all future advances that may be made to Mortgagor by Mortgagee, to be evidenced by promissory notes, and all renewal and extensions thereof, the maximum principal amount of all existing indebtedness and future advances outstanding at any one time not to exceed \$15,000 plus interest thereon, attorneys' fees and court costs as provided herein."
