...and the mortgage(s) in the full and just sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred and No/100

at 12 balloon st. in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of 8% per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly DOLLARS (\$ 4,500.00), to be paid

installments as follows:
Beginning on the 15th day of December 1969, and on the 15th day of each month of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 125.00 thereafter until the principal and interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue to be applied on the interest are paid in full, the aforesaid monthly payments of \$125.00 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of eight (8 %) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 4,500.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part hereof, as herein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.
