"ALL that certain piece, part or lot of land with all improvements thereon, or hereafter connected thereto, situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ~~Greenville~~ Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 24 on Plat of Maple Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "MM", Page 31 and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds; to-wit:
