

4/27/62*, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to John S. Gleason, Jr., as Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Office of the United States of America, and his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Thirteen Thousand and Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$13,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of Five & One-Fourth per centum ($\frac{1}{4} \frac{1}{4}$ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of the Loan Guaranty Officer, Veterans Administration Regional Office, at Columbia, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Seventy-Four and 56/100----- Dollars (\$74.56), commencing on the 5th day of May, 1961, and continuing on the 5th day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the 5th day of April, 1991.

Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagee, will pay to the Mortgagee at and before the making and delivery of this
