in and by its certain promissory note in writing of even date hereof, due and payable as follows:
One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars on the first day of October, 1964,
One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars on the first day of October, 1965,
One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars on the first day of October, 1966,
One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars on the first day of October, 1967,
One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars on the first day of October, 1968 and
Five Hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars on the first day of October, 1969 with the
privilege to anticipate payment of the entire principal debt or any part thereof at any
time prior to maturity, without penalty,
with interest from the date of this note at the rate of five percent per annum
until paid; interest to be computed and paid generally on the last day of each month when due to
bear interest at same rate as provided until paid, and it being further provided and agreed to pay six per

All the certain place, part or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the north western side of Summit-Drive, being shown on the Greenville County Block Books as Lot No. 52, Block 2, Sheet 132, and having, according to various surveys (see Plat Book R, at Page 133, Plat Book NN, at Page 109 and Plat Book ZZ at Page 142 in said R. Douglas Wilson as shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book R, at Page 133; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 3, 4 and 5 of said subdivision, and continuing along the rear line of a lot conveyed to C. L. Hoffman by deed recorded in Deed Volume 154, at Page 423, N. 74-55 E. 202.3 feet, running to an iron pin at the southeastern corner of the Hoffman
