It further appears from the Affidavit of Allen Dedwyler, legal representative of the Greenville News-Piedmont, a newspaper printed and published in Greenville County, South Carolina that the Rule to Show Cause issued by this Court to Respondent was published in the Greenville News-Piedmont on January 8, 15 and 22.

It further appears by Affidavit of Mason A. Goldsmith that a copy of the Rule to Show Cause and the Verified Petition was mailed to Respondent by United States mail with postage prepaid at two (2) addresses at which Respondent had accepted mail containing the demands to satisfy the mortgage, these being P. O. Box 331, Wallington, New Jersey, 07057 and Suite A-6, 101 Kennedy Street, Spring Valley, New York, 10977.

Petitioner and her attorney, Mason A. Goldsmith appeared on Friday, Pebruary 6 1976 at 9:30 a.m. and although Petitioner and her attorney and the Court waited for over forty-five (45) minutes, Respondent failed to appear; Petitioner's attorney presented to the Court return receipts marked Exhibits for Petitioner 1 and 2, same being introduced as the return receipts for the envelopes containing demands upon Respondent to mark the mortgage paid and satisfied in full.

This Court finds and it is so ordered that Petitioners have paid to the Respondent all sums due him and although demand has been made upon Respondent for return of the original mortgage marked "Paid, satisfied in full and cancelled", such original note and mortgage have not been forthcoming; that this Court finds and so orders that the mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 1247 at Page 346 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County be marked cancelled by order of this Court by the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
