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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, Dated September 5, 1968.  
THEREAS, the undersigned Earle R. Solesbee and Kathleen S. Solesbee,

residing in Greenville, County, South Carolina, whose post office address is  
Route One (1), Taylors, South Carolina 29687, herein called "Borrower,"  
are (is) jointly indebted to the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of  
Agriculture, herein called the "Government," as evidenced by a certain promissory note, herein called "the note," dated  
September 5, 1968, for the principal sum of Eleven Thousand and No/100  
Dollars (\$11,000.00), with interest at the rate of Five percent (5%) per annum, executed by Borrower  
and payable to the order of the Government in installments as specified therein, the final installment being due on Sept. 5, 2001,  
which note authorizes acceleration of the entire indebtedness at the option of the Government upon any default by Borrower; and

THEREAS, the note evidences a loan to Borrower in the principal amount specified therein, made with the purpose and intention that  
the Government, at any time, may assign the note and issue the payment thereof pursuant to the Consolidated Farmers Home Administration  
Act of 1961, or Title V of the Housing Act of 1949; and

THEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, it may be assigned from time to time and each holder of the insured  
note, in turn, will be the insured lender; and

THEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along  
with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured lender in connection with the loan; and

THEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insured lender set forth in the  
insurance endorsement may be entitled to a satisfied
