1. To pay prior to becoming delinquent, all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below; and
2. Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein; and
3. Hereby assign, transfer and set over to Bank, its successors and assigns, all monies now due and hereafter becoming due to the undersigned, as rental, or otherwise, and howsoever for or on account of that certain real property situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

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All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with improvements thereon, lying and being in Bates township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at or near curve in Road, at iron pin, common corner of Ralph E. Wells and Hudson property, NE 26 E 200 feet, Jones line; 858-35 E, still along said road, 200 feet to branch; thence along said branch SW 445 feet; thence N 60-10 W, 260 feet to beginning corner, and containing three-fourths of an acre, more or less.



5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

6. Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
