I, J.W. Gray, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING: WHEREAS, Lizzie V. Cox, and others

on or about the twenty-seventh day of September in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nine exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Toy L. Cox and others

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the twelfth day of October 1909, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by J.W. Gray, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate for sale by public outcry on the first day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nine did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the same unto B.L. Smith

for the sum of Eighteen hundred and ten Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor. NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, J.W. Gray Master in and for County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred and ten Dollars, to me paid by the said B.L. Smith

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said B.L. Smith, All that certain parcel or tract of land, lying, being and situate in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, containing thirty-four and three-fourths (34-3/4) acres, more or less, known as tract No. 2 in the survey of the lands of Lewis R. Cox, deceased made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor on the 21st day of September, 1909 and having the following metes and bounds, as shown by plat of said survey, to wit: Beginning at a stake in middle of Pelham Road, corner of tract No. 3 and running thence S. 68-1/2 E. 13.20 to stone; thence N. 11 E. 34.40 to stone; thence N. 65-7/8 W. 7.89 to stone in Pelham road; thence along said road as a line S. 21-1/8 W. 8.55 to bend in road; thence S. 18-1/2 W. 7.45 to P. oak, corner of tracts 1 and 3; thence S. 13-1/4 W. 10.00 to point in road; where another road intersects said road; thence S. 24 W. 3.60 to bend in road; thence S. 32-1/4 W. 4.50 to the beginning corner.
