J. Moseley's land; thence S. 82 1/2 W. 6.90 to a stake 3x; thence S. 9 1/2 W. 41.00 to a stone 3x, on said new cut road; thence with said road 6.65 to the beginning, adjoining lands of A. J. Moseley and C. P. Rhodes homestead, and others, containing 28 acres, more or less.

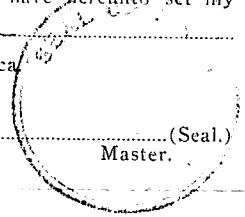
