J. Breazeale Austin (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. Breazeale Austin, All and singular, all of our one-third interest each undivided of the lands of Thos. W. Austin, deceased in and to that certain tract, parcel or piece of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, containing One hundred and thirty-six and 56/100 (136.56/100) acres, more or less and bounded as follows: on the North by lands of Campbell and Hodge place; on the East by lands of John Oliver and W.V. Kirby; on the South by lands of W.V. Kirby and J.E. Knight and on the west by lands of J.W. Thompson.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.
