(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

M.C. Stone, All that certain, piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing forty and 7/10 acres, more or less and being a part of the Benson Harrison place, more fully described by plat made by James P.-Willis, Surveyor, which is on record in R.M.C. office Greenville County, said plat made Oct. 6, 1913.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

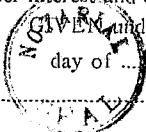
