 by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
E. C. Watson, his heirs and assigns forever; All that certain piece,
parcel and lots of land situate lying and being in Greenville
County, near the incorporate limits of Greenville City, State of
South Carolina. Beginning at an iron pin on the north side
of Davis St. corner of lots 1 & 2 and running thence with Davis
St. S. 68-50 E. 41 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 2 & 3; thence N. 31-
39 E. 87.8 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 2-3-16 & 17 thence with
the dividing line of lots 2 & 17-41 feet to an iron pin corner of
lots 1-2-17 & 18, thence S. 31-45 W. 99.5 feet to an iron pin the beginning
corner. Also that other lot of land on the corner of Davis & Foster

in all of that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid, on the
north side of East Stone Avenue and known as Lot 21 on the
plat of lands of Mountain City Land & Improvement Co., said
plat is recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County in
Book T. V., at page 542, and having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of
East Stone Avenue, at the point corner of lots 20 and 21, and
