KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, the said May Brown, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of my child, Troy, of the age of six (6) years, to C.A. Trammell, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,

TOGETHER with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by me, as parent, over and in respect to my said child, Troy,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Troy against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right or privilege through me in and to the said Troy,
