E.E. Ashmore and T.W. Ashmore (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the
said E.E. Ashmore and T.W. Ashmore, All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying
and being in in Grove Township, County and State aforesaid, containing thirty-two and seven-
tenths (32-7/10) acres, more or less, more fully described as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at a stone 3XOM on west side of Fork Shoals road and running thence S. 50-1/2 W.
14.46 chains to stone 3XOM; thence N. 86-1/8 W. 8.75 to stone 3XOM; thence S. 13 E. 16.05 to
stone 3XOM; thence N. 64-1/2 E. 25.33 to iron pin 3XOM in fork Shoals Road; thence with said
road N. 25-1/4 W. 16.46 to stone 3XOM; thence S. 9-1/2 E. 1.61 to the beginning corner, said
