NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That R. M. DeShazo of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS to W. L. McDaniel in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. L. McDaniel all and singular, all those two pieces, lots or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, about two and one-half miles from the Court House and on the South side of the Air Line Railway, near the Pendleton Road, having the following meter and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at corner of lot number one and an alley ten feet wide and running thence with said alley South sixty feet to an iron pin on said alley, thence North & West 144 feet to an iron pin on Vicar Scott's line, thence with Vicar Scott's line N. 14 E. 56 1/2 feet to a corner of lot number one, thence with lot number one S. 86 W. 144 feet to the beginning corner. Said lots are numbers two and three, being those same lots which were conveyed to John S. Henry and Cornelia Henry by Cornelia Henry by Deed recorded in R. M. B. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 27 at Page 384 and being all the real property owned by the said John S. Henry and Cornelia Henry in that section of Greenville County known as Sweetown.
