NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I George W. Stone of the
County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
George W. Arnold of the same County and State

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
George W. Arnold his heirs and assigns forever,
all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land
situate lying and being in Oak Lawn Town-
ship, in the County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, about fifteen miles from the City of
Greenville on the Augusta Road, being known
as the Stansell Place, and having the metes
and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone
84 1/2 E. 15.11 to a stone, thence S. 22 1/2 E. 16.58 to a stone
thence S. 85 W. 23.06 to a stone, thence N. 5 1/4 E.
to the beginning point containing thirty
acres more or less and bounded by lands
of W. B. Lindley, J. M. King and others and
being the same tract of land conveyed by
the heirs at law of B. S. Stansell, deceased, to
H. D. Stansell by deed bearing date 26 day of
Aug. A. D. 1905 and recorded in R. M. C. Office
Greenville Co. in Book m m m, Page 552 and
conveyed by said H. D. Stansell to me on Feb.
5, 1914 and recorded in R. M. C. Office Greenville
Co., in Vol. 28 Page 380.

every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
