 in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of Seventeen Hundred + 00/100 DOLLARS,  
 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
C. M. White

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. M. White his heirs and assigns, all that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about two miles West of the City of Greenville and being a portion of a subdivision known as "City Shier". Beginning at a stake at North East corner of Henderson and Orrell street, and running thence N. 0-30 E. 150 feet to a stake corner of lots Nos. 39 + 40 thence S. 89 1/2 E. 150 feet to a stake in a ten foot alley, thence along said alley S. 0-30 W. 150 feet to a stake on Orrell Street, thence along said Street N. 89 1/2 W. 150 ft. to the beginning corner and being composed of three lots, designated as lots Nos. 37-38 + 39 as shown by a plat made by J. A. Adams surveyor. Said plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and being the same lots conveyed to us by D. H. Kicke 14th Sept. 1912 and recorded in the R. M. C.
