 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That O Mills Goodlett of the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand and Two Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. F. Robinson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. F. Robinson, his heirs and assigns forever:
 All that piece parcel or lot of land, commencing at an iron pin on South side of Whitsett Street, joint corner of lots # 1 & 2, thence S. 15-0 E. One hundred twenty six feet one inch along joint lines of said lots to an iron pin on a ten foot alley; thence N. 76-45 E. Sixty six feet eight inches to an iron pin, joint corner of lots # 2 & 3; thence N. 15-0 W. along lines of said lots one hundred twenty six feet one inch to an iron pin on Whitsett Street; thence S. 76-45 W. Sixty six feet eight inches along said street to an iron pin, the beginning corner. The same being known and designated as lot number Two of Block Three on the plat of Boyce addition recorded in said Office of R. M. C. in plat Book 12 at page 179.

Being the same lot conveyed to me by Nannie R. Kuehler on the 1st day of October, 1912, my said deed being of record in R. M. C. Office in Vol. 21 at page 229 of the said R. M. C. AND I do hereby bind Myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said L. F. Robinson, his heirs and assigns, forever.
