NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Noah M. Cannon

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R. M. Hallingsworth

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

R. M. Hallingsworth, all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the town of Greer and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:—

Beginning at an iron pin on James Street, and running almost north with Bates line 152 1/2 feet to an iron pin, thence East 55 feet to iron pin, thence almost South 153 feet to an iron pin on James Street, thence East 55 feet to beginning corner, being part of lots #9 and #10 made from G. P. Lewis subdivision for Noah M. Cannon, also being said land conveyed to me by Noah Cannon.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said R. M. Hallingsworth his heirs and assigns, forever.
