NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Dorthula Newman (formerly Dorthula Mullinex or Trammell) of Cleveland County, in the State of North Carolina
in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five hundred (\$2500.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W.N. Dorsey, of Cleveland County, N.C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W.N. Dorsey, and his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Seluda Township and containing Two hundred and fifty (250) acres, more or less, bounded by lands now or formerly of N.E. Poole, Wm. Turner, W.D. Pitman and others; this being the same land conveyed to me by Wilson Trammell by his deed bearing date 29th, day of August 1892, and recorded in the Register of Mesne Conveyances Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book "Y.Y", at page 456, to which reference is hereby made.

Dorsey, and his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
