NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Elizabeth H. Long
in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Forty-Five Hundred DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Dorothy M. Barber

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Dorothy M. Barber her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate on the east side of David street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of David street, which pin is the northwest corner of the lot owned by D. S. David, and running thence N. 24. 15 W. 90 feet with David street to an iron pipe at the corner of David street and a twenty foot alley, which belongs to the City; thence with said alley N. 89. 8 E. 171. 7 feet to an iron pipe which is the corner of C. A. David's property; thence running with his line S. 17. 40 E. 21. 7 feet to an iron pipe which is the northeast corner of D. S. David's property; thence S. 65. 45 W. 155 feet with D. S. David's line to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by Daisy S. De Mulder, by deed dated the 22nd day of September 1917, and recorded in Vol. 52 page 42.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Dorothy M. Barber, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Dorothy M. Barber, her

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
