the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

Duff Jamison, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All that piece parcel or tract of land, situate lying and being in Grove Township, County of Dark Habersham, and bounded by lands of a Mr. Anderson, and lands formerly owned and lands of Piedmont Cotton Mill Company and containing twelve (12) acres, more or less and being the same lands devised by Sara Jane Stegall, the mother of Mrs. Mattie Jamison, by will dated Dec. 9, 1920, and on record in the office of Judge of Probate, County and State aforesaid in Department 172, file No. 3.
