HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Mamie Minus, Lot No. 9

of the property of the late D. M. Minus, as shown by a plat on record in the R. M. C.

Office for Greenville County, said lot having a dwelling thereon, the residence of the late

D. M. Minus, fronting on an alley towards Sterling School, 50 feet, and having a depth of

75 feet and joining Lot No. 5 in the rear and running parallel with Lot No. 5 for a dis-

tance of 50 feet to an alley; running thence along said alley to the alley that fronts

towards Sterling School and the beginning point, all of which dimensions will more fully

appear by reference to a plat recorded in Vol. F, at Page 146, R. M. C. Office for Green-

ville County.

Being a portion of the Estate of D. M. Minus, deceased, in Greenville Township, State

of South Carolina.
