demanding judgement in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 15th
day of November, 19 46, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a _____ Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the
County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having

dispose of the same unto Nannie Terry Norris

being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, now All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said Nannie Terry Norris

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the
said Nannie Terry Norris

"All that tract or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South
Carolina, at or near Grove Station, containing four and one-half acres, more or less, bounded
on the East by J. A. Norris and the Pelzer dirt road, on the west by the Columbia and Greenville
Railroad, and on the South by lands of Julius Eskew or settlement dirt road, being the same
conveyed to the said J. A. Norris, by U. A. Cooper by his deed dated January 2, 1919, recorded
in R. M. C. Office for said County in Deed Book 44, Page 331."
