All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in  
Greenville County, in the State aforesaid and in the Township of Saluda, on Cases Creek,  
branch waters of Mush Creek and South Tyger River and runs as follows; Beginning at a  
stone corner on the Public Road which leads from the State road into the Buncombe Road  
at Lima, and is a corner of the lands formerly owned by J. Henry Trammell, J.D. Case  
and W. T. Storey, and runs thence with Storey line to a Stone Corner on the place now  
or formerly known as the Holly line, thence with the Holly line a South West direction  
to a Stone Corner, thence North East with Storeys line to a Stone Corner, Thence North East  
to an Iron pin in Creek, thence with the meanders of said Creek and said Storeys line to a  
stone on the said Henry Trammells line, thence in an easterly direction and with said  
Trammells line to a Stone Corner on said Public Road, thence in a Northerly direction with  
Trammells line to the beginning corner, containing sixty-seven(67) acres more or less.
