R. B. Vaughn all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chicks Springs Township, adjoining lands of Mrs. E. T. Westmoreland and R. B. Vaughn, and being the same land conveyed to the trustees of the Fairview School by R. B. Vaughn by deed bearing date of Jan. 24th 1916, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 39 at page 160, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: Beginning at an iron pin on the North East side of the Buncombe Road, on the line between Mrs. E. T. Westmoreland and R. B. Vaughn, and runs thence N. 9 1/2 E. 5.07 chs. to an iron on the aforementioned line; thence S. 63 1/8 E. 4.12 chs. to an iron pin; thence S. 9 1/2 W. 5.07 chs. to an iron pin in the Buncombe Road; thence with the road N. 63 1/8 W. 4.12 chs. to the beginning corner containing two (2) acres more or less.
