KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Thomas T. Goldsmith, Executor of the Estate of Mary Furman Goldsmith

in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)

to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by

Lola Timms

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Lola Timms, Her Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot No. 14 on plat of Furman Terrace, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March 1937, which plat is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I, at page 59, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Furman Hall Road which pin is the joint corner of Lots No. 13 and 14 and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 60-30 W. 155 feet to an iron pin at the Eastern corner of Lot No. 17; thence along the line of Lot No. 17, N. 5-10 E. 56 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 14 and 15; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots, S. 66-40 E. 179.5 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Furman Hall Road; thence along the Western side of Furman Hall Road S. 29-30 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1947.
