FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is GREENVILLE GUN CLUB, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to promote the art of trap and/or skeet shooting; to influence the proper protection and propagation of game and fish, to influence and promote proper and skilled use of fire arms and to foster good fellowship among sportsmen and to foster clean, proper and true sportsmanship.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty-five hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars, payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is one hundred (100) Dollars of the par value of Twenty-five (\$25.00)

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 25th day of June, 19 47, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: Thomas W. Miller, Harold R. Turner, D. B. Leatherwood, J. B. Norman, J. D. Isbell, W. H. Arnold, Thomas C. Furman and Frank M. Heidt

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President W. A. Chandler 1st. as Vice-President, Charles M. Bauskett; as Secretary, Romaine Barnes as Treasurer, Romaine Barnes as 2nd. V-Pres.: Edward L. Weber

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent, of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

Greenville News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
