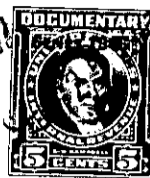
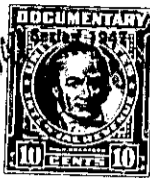

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of U.S. Highway No. 25,  
leading from Greenville to Travelers Rest, S. C. at the joint corner of  
Lots Nos. 4 and 5; and running thence in a Northerly direction along the  
Western side of said Highway 140 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on  
said Highway at corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 on said plat; thence along  
the line of said lots in a westerly direction 34 feet, more or less, to  
an iron pin on the East side of Paris Mountain Road; thence along the
