(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James L. Henson and Luannie Catherine

Henson, their heirs and assigns forever:-

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of the Brannon Road, and runs thence N 37-27 E four hundred seventy-one and eight-tenths (471.8) feet to a stake on line of #14 lot; thence S 48-33 E one hundred ninety-one and four-tenths (191.4) feet to a stake on the I. B. Brannon line; thence with said line, S 37-27 W five hundred twenty-one and four-tenths (521.4) feet to iron pin on Brannon Road; thence with the said road, N. 34-07 W two hundred (200) feet to the beginning corner, and shown as lot #11 on plat of the R. B. Vaughn property, and being a part of the same conveyed to the grantor by deed of J. B. and Alex Brookshire.

ALSO, that other lot or parcel of land in said Township, said County and State, and described as follows;

Beginning at iron pin in new road leading to Fairview Church at corner of lot #8, and runs thence N 50 E 9.21 chains to iron pin in branch; thence N 49 W 4.03 chains to a poplar stump near a dry ditch; thence S 37 W 8.67 chains to iron pin in the new road; thence along said new road, S 34 E 2.00 chains to the beginning corner, containing two and sixty-four one-hundredths (2.64) acres, more or less, and designated as lot #9 on plat of the I. B. Brannon lands, by J. Earle Freeman, Oct. 5th, 1927.

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
