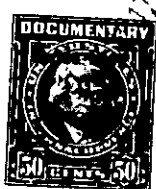

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid on the east side of Mary Street, known and designated as lot #66, Map #1, of the Camilla Park Subdivision as shown by plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "G" at page 225, and according to said plat, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Mary Street, which iron pin measures 136 feet north from the northeastern intersection of Mary Street and Frances Avenue, and running thence along the east side of Mary Street N. 20-45 W. 68 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot #67; thence along line of lot #67 N. 67-54 E. 191.9 feet to an iron pin on 20 foot alley; thence along said 20 foot alley S. 18-32 E. 67.95 ft. to an iron pin at rear corner of lot #65; thence along line of lot #65 S. 67-52 W. 189.2 ft. to the point of beginning.
