of South Carolina, (and being known and designated as the rear portion of Lot 54, Brookwood Drive, as shown on plat recorded in the R.M.C, Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "J" at page 209, and having, according to survey made by L. B. Aull, Jr., Registered Engineer and Land Surveyor on September 6, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Brook-wood Drive, which point is 199.8 feet in an Easterly direction from the intersection of Sevier Street with Brookwood Drive and running thence along the South side of Brookwood Drive S. 70-08 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 29-02 W. 95 feet to an iron pin on the joint rear corner of Lots 54 and 55; thence along the line of Lots 54 and 55, N. 70-08 W. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20-30 E. 94 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Brookwood Drive, the point of beginning.
