by ANSEL A. KING  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said OLLIE FARNSWORTH  
Forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, is the East side of Dunklin bridge road  
beginning on the Northwest and Southeast by lands of A. King  
to the Northwest by Dunklin bridge road, to the Northwest  
of J. D. Sims, containing one (1) acre, more or less,  
according to a plat made by J. E. Gary, Surveyor, on  
October 10, 1917, which plat shows the following corners  
and bearings:

beginning at an iron pin in center of Dunklin bridge road, 1/4 mi  
S. of J. D. Sims lot with S. King land, then along line of  
J. D. Sims N. 40° E. S. 10° E. line to 170 pin of J. D. Sims line;  
thence S. 80° E. S. 10° E. line to iron pin; thence S. 40° W.  
line to iron pin in center of Dunklin bridge road; thence  
along center of said road N. 80° E. S. 10° E. line to beginning  
of lot.
