

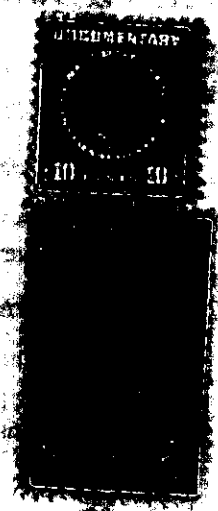

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Paul S. Poole,

to me ..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by E. C. Howard .....

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. C. Howard, and his Heirs and Assigns  
forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the east side of State Highway No. 14  
and on the north side of the road which leads therefrom at the old  
Tyger School place by the Press Barnett farm, bounded on the south  
by lands of W. T. Wooten, on the north and east by other lands of  
the Grantor, and on the west by Ralph Bright, containing 3.41 acres,  
more or less, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stone, being joint corner with Ralph Bright,  
C. B. Bright, and W. T. Wooten, and runs thence S. 48.15 E. 235  
feet to a iron pin on the edge of said Barnett Road; thence along  
said road N. 78.30 E. 165 feet to a turn; thence continuing with  
said road N. 88.30 E. 144.5 feet to an iron pin; thence a new line  
N. 11.30 W. 311 feet to a red oak, 3X nm; thence another new line  
N. 53.45 W. 276 feet to a pine, 3X, nm, on line of Ralph Bright's  
land; thence with his line S. 30 W. 393 feet to the beginning corner.
