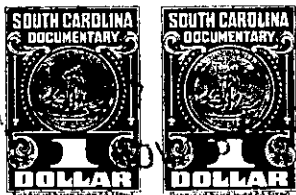

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That MARSMEN, INC.,

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

and having its principal place of business at
Greenville in the State of South Carolina

for and in consideration of the sum of FIVE HUNDRED FORTY (\$540.00) Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Margaret I. Brissey, her Heirs and Assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southeast corner of Hull Drive and Churchill Circle, and being known and designated as lot No. 98 of Augusta Acres, property of Marsmen, Inc., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "P", page 25, and having according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Hull Drive, joint corner of lots Nos. 98 and 113, and running thence with line of lot No. 113, N. 68-47 E., 82.3 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 98 and 99; thence with line of lot No. 99, N. 15-45 W., 236 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Churchill Circle; thence with Churchill Circle, S. 74-15 W., 74.1 feet to an iron pin; thence in a curved line, S. 26-59 W., 36 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Hull Drive; thence with Hull Drive, S. 20-18 E, 216.2 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

Included in the above consideration is the right to tap a two (2) inch water line owned by the Grantor. Grantor to pay 1947 taxes.

This is a portion of the property conveyed by Mary I Meadors to MARSMEN, INC., by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 290 at page 143, and a portion of this land, including the above lot, is being developed as a restricted residential district and is sold subject to the following restrictions, which constitute a part of the consideration hereof, and shall be effective for a period of fifty (50) years from the date hereof:

- 1- Said property is to be sold or used for residential purposes only.
- 2- No residence shall be erected thereon at a cost of less than \$5,000.00
- 3- No building to be erected nearer that 30 feet from Churchill Circle.
- 4- No outside toilets to be permitted after the installation of waterlines.
- 5- No part of this property to be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any person of African descent.
