And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their successors in office ~~heirs and assigns~~, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

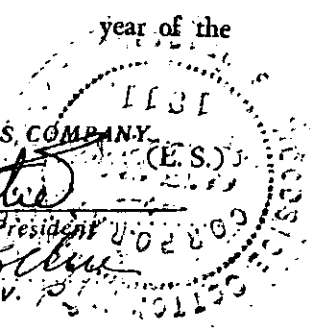
