Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Pauline Bush Shane, nee:

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mrs. S. M. Sullivan, her heirs and assigns, all of my right, title and interest, same being a one-eighth ($1/8$) undivided interest in and to:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit; and being approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles from City of Greenville in section known as Freetown, BEGINNING at a stake on Lot No. 1 and ten foot alley; thence with said alley S. 14 E. 60 feet to a stake; thence West 44 feet to a stake on Vicker Scott's line; thence N. 13.30 W. $56\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake at corner of Lots Numbers one and two; thence with line of Lot Number One due East 144 feet to the beginning.

This being my undivided interest in the above described property inherited by me from my mother, Mrs. L. C. E.
