

BEGINNING at a point in the middle of road adjacent to lands of Sam Willimon where said road touches White Horse Road, thence along the center of said road N. 68-45 W. 283 ft. to a point in the center of said road, thence N. 11-15 E. 125 ft. to iron pin joint rear corners of lots 3 and 4, thence S. 68-45 E. along the boundary line of lots 3 and 4 283 ft. to iron pin on White Horse Road, thence S. 9-47 W. 125 ft. along the White Horse Road to the point of beginning, this being a portion of the property deeded to the grantors by W.
