Thomas G. Crymes, Jr. and Marvin Crymes, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing three and eightysix one-hundredths (3.86) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds:-

BEGINNING on stone in road; thence with said road S. 77 1/4 W. 11.11 to an iron pin in road; thence S. 34 1/2 E. 4.00 to an iron pin; thence N. 77 1/4 E. 9.67 to an iron pin; thence N. 12-3/4 W. 3.72 to the beginning corner and more fully represented by a plat made by William F. Lee, Surveyor, dated July 3, 1916.
