Greenville, South Carolina, made by W.J. Riddle, August 1937  
from this Plat the following description is taken:

Beginning at a point on the Eastern edge of Bennett  
Street which point is located 180 ft. from the South Eastern corner  
of Bennett Street to Fairview Avenue, and running thence along the  
edge of Bennett Street N.34-07 E. 120 ft. to the joint corner of  
lots 2 and 3; thence their joint line S.67-03 E.168 ft. to the
